The table count was 150+ rivaling a normal Summer Show, even with the OVMS date overlay. We estimated a loss of approximately 30 tables to OVMS. The data from our Summer Show gate numbers recorded for 2012 & 2013 were 710 and 894. Our gate this time was ~692. Friday we estimated approximately 208 and Saturday 484. This is our first "dip" in the summer gate statistics since 2007. We will discuss in detail other factors that may have contributed to the lower gate numbers, however a single marginal occurrence should be considered an anomaly IMO, but certainly something we will watch. We have moved our 2016 Summer Show to the second weekend in June, the 10th & 11th so it will not conflict with OVMS.

We had 12 Members from TMCA attend and hope they enjoyed their stay in HSV and our Show and return home with positive reports! We are looking forward to their invitation to join them in Cool Springs this Fall!
